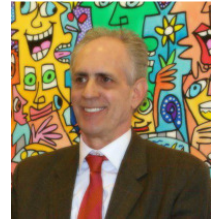

Following the central theme "For a better future...", the MTZ@foundation (Monika and Thomas Zimmermann) fosters science and research in the field of Human Medicines. It supports the classical scientific research approach of postgraduates (also post-doctorands) in the cellular and genetic domain, as well as within the innovative field of medical Systems Biology that deciphers complex, cross-linked biological phenomena of cells, tissue and organisms and translates them into realistic computer models by means of an interdisciplinary approach. The main objective is to significantly contribute to the conquest of diseases by investigating on their origins and coherences.

Especially when it comes to maintaining the quality of life within an increasingly ageing society, bio-ethical issues play an important role in the goals of the MTZ@ foundation.

MTZ- Award for Medical Systems Biology 2008

Offering the MTZ[®] – Award for Medical Systems Biology 2008 should foster future-oriented research approaches in the field of medical Systems Biology. The award is granted by the MTZ foundation in order to appreciate outstanding dissertations in the field of medical Systems Biology on a prominent level, with the aim of drawing special attention and public recognition to the promising scientific young talents. On this behalf, the MTZ foundation cooperates with the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). The award promotes young scientists that outstandingly contribute to the research in Systems Biology. The prize value is divisible and shall be assigned for the three best dissertations. The award is offered for the first time.
